ALCHEMY in Florence



Alchemy is the ancient art of transforming lead into gold. Throughout this weeklong retreat, Patricia Masters, licensed marriage and family therapist, will guide you through a series of contemplative exercises and guided meditations to begin taking the steps to transform the "leaden" areas of your life into your inner gold. You will come away from this retreat with a better understanding of how to integrate all parts of yourself into your life's journey.

At the same time, you will have a hands-on metalsmithing experience creating your own 18k gold ring as physical symbol of your inner journey.





Our home away from home will be a beautifully restored 14th century palazzo (palace) located in the heart of the artisan "Oltrarno" district of Florence. Each shared room is an apartment style accommodation with kitchenettes and dining areas, allowing you the option to eat in if you so choose. The palazzo is situated within easy walking distance to the studio where the ring making will take place. In this neighborhood of Florence you can still find the local artisans carrying on old traditions of

Italian craft. Amazing restaurants, boutique shops, and the best gelato in the city are found here.
